Cancer Institute

AHN Cancer Institute specializes in diagnosing cancer at its earliest stages and offering advanced treatments and surgeries, even for the most aggressive cancers.

Most patients meet with their care team within three days of diagnosis.

By focusing on the whole individual, we tailor each treatment so we meet the specific needs of that patient and offer support services like pain management, nutrition, rehabilitation, behavioral health, and cancer genetics.



WORLD-CLASS EXPERTISE

AHN brings comprehensive cancer care closer to home — while keeping it connected to sophisticated programs at our academic hospitals. We deliver the majority of all cancer care — including medical oncology and radiation oncology — at more than 20 locations in communities throughout western Pennsylvania. Patients spend less time, energy, and money traveling, so they can focus more on recovery and getting back to their lives.

The AHN Cancer Institute at Allegheny General Hospital, which opened in 2020, serves as the hub of collaborative cancer research. We opened new community locations on the Forbes Hospital campus in Monroeville and at Saint Vincent Hospital in Erie. We also added cancer care sites in Beaver, Butler, and Westmoreland counties.

NAVIGATORS PROVIDE SUPPORT, EVERY STEP OF THE WAY

Each patient has a nurse navigator. Nurse navigators help coordinate appointments, tests, and treatments, provide financial counseling, and connect patients with support services.

Bringing the brightest minds together

At AHN Cancer Institute, we're working with Johns Hopkins Kimmel Cancer Center to share breakthroughs, improve best practices, and accelerate advancements. Our collaboration also provides streamlined and guided access to clinical trials and second opinions.

AHN Cancer Institute and Johns Hopkins Medicine specialists collaborate on a tumor board. Oncologists, genetic experts, and molecular pathologists from AHN and Johns Hopkins review tumor sequencing reports and determine targeted therapies. It helps to determine potential treatment options for advanced or rare tumors.

Innovation highlights

- CAR T-cell therapy is a type of immunotherapy that uses the patient's own T-cells to recognize and attack cancer cells.
- Stereotactic body radiotherapy
 (SBRT) uses sophisticated technology
 to identify the precise location of
 the tumor and delivers a high-dose
 of external radiation in just a few
 sessions with pinpoint accuracy.
- MR-linac is a breakthrough technology that generates magnetic resonance images (MRI) and delivers radiation beams at the same time. Doctors can see tumor tissue more clearly and adapt the radiation dose during treatment. AHN is one of the few facilities in the country testing the MR-linac.

Cardiovascular Institute



AHN Cardiovascular Institute (CVI) has a long history of innovation and research. We focus on evidence-based medicine, medical ingenuity, and groundbreaking therapies.

Working with specialists in other disciplines, we provide the most effective treatment for heart failure, coronary artery disease, atrial fibrillation, structural heart disease, pulmonary hypertension, vascular disease, aortic disease, thoracic disease, and other cardiovascular conditions.

Our interventional teams perform acute percutaneous coronary and valve interventions and other high-risk procedures, like chronic total occlusions and treatments for cardiogenic shock.

PIONEERING NEW CARE OPTIONS

We are leaders in using new innovation in robotic-assisted surgery, mechanical circulatory support, and heart arrhythmia treatments.

As early adopters of advanced surgical techniques, we have years of experience with transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR), a minimally invasive, lifesaving option for individuals with aortic valve stenosis.

We have treated the most complex heart transplant cases while improving post-transplant outcomes. Our customized immunosuppression plans include gene expression profiling, identification of donor DNA in the recipient, and aggressive surveillance and treatment of cardiac allograft vasculopathy to minimize organ rejection.

Our doctors helped to pioneer the clinical application of the left ventricular assist device (LVAD), which improves survival and quality of life for individuals with advanced heart failure.

Our electrophysiologists initiated an ablation technique that uses low or zero fluoroscopy to significantly decrease radiation exposure while restoring normal heart rhythm.

Certifications and rankings

AHN heart transplant program has the best waitlist survival rate in the region.

Allegheny General Hospital (AGH) and West Penn Hospital have been awarded the American Heart Association's (AHA) Comprehensive Hypertension Center Certification. They are the only sites in western Pennsylvania with this prestigious award.

AGH is the first hospital in Pennsylvania to receive the Mitral Valve Repair Reference Center Award from the American Heart Association (AHA) and the Mitral Foundation.

AGH is designated as a Center of Excellence for extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) by the Extracorporeal Life Support Organization (ELSO).

AGH is the first Academic Medical Center in Pennsylvania to earn The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval for comprehensive cardiac care. AGH, Allegheny Valley, Forbes, Jefferson, Saint Vincent, and West Penn hospitals have been designated with the American Heart Association's (AHA) Get With The Guidelines® 2021 Heart Failure Gold Plus Achievement Award.

AGH has earned the maximum three-star rating from the Society of Thoracic Surgeons (STS) for the quality and patient outcomes of its leading cardiovascular surgery program. It's the first in the western Pennsylvania region to report the highest-level of achievement across three categories of transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR), coronary bypass grafting (CABG), aortic valve replacement (AVR), and mitral valve repair and replacement.

Innovation highlights


- Zero fluoroscopy atrial fibrillation ablation is a procedure that uses intracardiac echocardiography (ICE) instead of radiation (fluoroscopy).
- Coronary brachytherapy is a therapy that uses radioactive microbeads to treat coronary in-stent restenosis.
- Coronary CT angiography with HeartFlow^{®†} is a 3D rendering of the heart to improve the diagnostic accuracy of coronary disease and reduce the need for cardiac catheterizations.
- Innovative cardiovascular technology
 is used to perform advanced heart
 surgery with minimally invasive and
 robotic-assisted techniques, heart valve
 and vascular surgery, and mechanical
 heart assistance.

- Transcatheter interventions are procedures used to treat mitral and tricuspid valve regurgitation.
- Pulmonary thromboendarterectomy (PTE) and balloon pulmonary angioplasty (BPA) is used for the management of chronic thrombo-embolic pulmonary hypertension (CTEPH).
- Septal myectomy and alcohol septal ablation are procedures used to treat hypertrophic obstructive cardiomyopathy (HOCM). AHN is one of a few health systems in the country that offers them.
- Stereotactic radiation therapy (STAR) treats refractory ventricular arrhythmia. AGH physicians are among the first in the country to use it.





Emergency Services



Our board-certified emergency physicians, specially trained emergency nurses, and clinical staff assess the situation quickly so we can begin treatment as soon as possible.

Our hospital emergency departments have some of the shortest average wait times in the region, keeping emergency care close at hand for thousands of area residents.

We have expanded care to more communities with 24/7 emergency services at our new neighborhood hospitals in Brentwood, Harmar, Hempfield, and McCandless.

We offer two emergency medicine residency programs, as well as fellowships in pre-hospital medicine and emergency ultrasound.

TRAUMA CENTERS

Our trauma programs treat more than 5,000 people each year.

- Level II Trauma Center at Forbes Hospital.
- Level I Trauma Center at Allegheny General Hospital.
- Burn unit for adults and children at West Penn Hospital.

STROKE CENTERS

The Joint Commission designates six AHN hospitals as centers for the treatment of complex stroke and cerebrovascular disease:

- Allegheny General Hospital as a Comprehensive Stroke Center.
- Allegheny Valley, Forbes, Jefferson, Saint Vincent, and West Penn hospitals as Primary Stroke Centers.

AIR TRANSPORT

LifeFlight transports critically ill and injured individuals while providing immediate, specialized care. The first of its kind in the northeastern United States, LifeFlight has five regional bases, covering a radius of 150 miles around Pittsburgh.



Medicine Institute

The AHN Medicine Institute includes specialists who provide exceptional care in Centers of Excellence across 14 subspecialties. Using innovative technologies and the newest research, our doctors develop novel diagnostic tools and treatment options.

We're committed to providing the highest level of education for the next generation of physicians and serve as one of the largest academic training centers in the region for medical professionals.



ACCESS TO UNIQUE PROGRAMS

With more than 600 providers in western Pennsylvania, we are a referral center for patients from around the world.

The AHN Dermatology program specializes in phototherapy for cutaneous T-cell lymphoma, eczema, psoriasis, and contact dermatitis. Our Mohs Micrographic Surgery Program uses an advanced surgical method for treating skin cancers that can decrease the risk of recurrence and provide optimal cosmetic results.*

With Advanced Therapeutic Endoscopy, we simplify and treat complex gastrointestinal (GI) and pancreatic disorders. Our team is uniquely trained in interventional endoscopy. We're the first in the region, and one of three locations in the country, that perform endoscopic stricturotomy.

The Center for Inclusion Health focuses on under-served populations with complex medical conditions. Our Healthy Food Centers assist those affected by food insecurity. Other people get help from our comprehensive Center for Recovery Medicine.

We're leading the way to improve outcomes and lower costs for patients with chronic conditions like diabetes, COPD, and chronic kidney disease. Our care model uses multi-disciplinary teams that tailor treatment for each individual.

Innovation highlights

The AHN Autoimmunity Institute, a one-of-a-kind facility, provides expert diagnosis and care for autoimmune disorders. We have dedicated Centers of Excellence for Lupus, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Celiac Disease, and Inflammatory Bowel Disease. Since opening in February 2018, we've cared for patients from 34 states.

The Center for Complementary and Integrative Health provides nontraditional services, like massage and acupuncture, to support patients with pain and other chronic conditions.

We're the first system in the region to offer bronchial thermoplasty treatments for severe asthma.

The Bariatric Metabolic Institute provides novel approaches to weight management, including Health Management Resources (HMR), an intensive lifestyle-change program designed to foster healthier routines and quicker weight loss. HMR includes structured meal plans and weekly visits with a coach in small group sessions.

AHN's Neuroscience Institute is an international referral center for brain, spine, and neurological conditions.

Our physicians are highly experienced at performing the newest procedures safely and effectively. We've made advancements in ending tremors and facial pain, treating brain cancer, and helping those with serious spine conditions to walk pain-free.

We're one of the country's foremost experts for deep brain stimulation to control and monitor symptoms of Parkinson's disease, essential tremor, dystonia, and other movement disorders.

Our surgeons are also leaders in performing microvascular decompression, including endoscopic approaches, to treat the facial pain caused by trigeminal neuralgia.

PIONEERS WITH MINIMALLY INVASIVE, **ROBOTIC-ASSISTED SURGERY**

We minimize trauma to the body during surgery and work to restore function as quickly as possible, using minimally invasive techniques.

As the first health system in the region to use Mazor X[™] robotic technology, combined with O-Arm™ real-time imaging, we treat spinal conditions safely, precisely, and with little disruption to patients' lives.

The neuroendoscopy program offers minimally invasive brain and spine surgery using innovative technology and instruments to reduce pain and recovery time, with little or no scarring.

Innovative care across the region

Staffed by stroke-trained neurologists, the stroke program delivers advanced, specialized care to patients at seven hospitals in western Pennsylvania. And, our Teleneurology program provides expert neurological evaluation and diagnosis by teaming up with doctors in suburban and rural community hospitals.

The Cerebrovascular Center offers medical, surgical, and rehabilitative care to individuals with blood vessel disorders, including stroke, arteriovenous malformation, carotid artery stenosis, cerebral aneurysm, and transient ischemic attack.

Committed to excellence

We have programs and specialists dedicated to caring for patients with ALS, epilepsy, headaches, multiple sclerosis, myasthenia gravis, and Parkinson's disease. Other dedicated programs include:

Cahouet Center for Comprehensive Parkinson's Care, AHN Epilepsy Center, Adult Hydrocephalus Center, AHN Pituitary Center, and Neuro-immunology for nervous system complications of autoimmune diseases, like multiple sclerosis, lupus, and rheumatoid arthritis.





Psychiatry and Behavioral Health

We offer comprehensive care to help people of all ages regain control of their mental, emotional, and behavioral health. Our team of specialists can identify the problems and create a plan that fits the patient's needs.

FINDING THE BEST ANSWER

These treatments can be used alone or with others, depending on the situation and diagnosis.

Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) and dialectical behavior therapy (DBT) teach skills that help patients develop ways of thinking and behaving that lead to healthier and more positive lives.

Stress management and relaxation therapy reduces anxiety and stress and develops constructive approaches to dealing with life events.

Medication therapy relieves some symptoms so the patient can focus on daily activities.



Taking the first step

Telepsychiatry allows patients to get interactive care through secure audio or video conferencing.

Outpatient counseling is conveniently located throughout the area, including many primary care practices, so patients can get care near to home or work.

Partial hospitalization combines group therapy, psychodynamic and interpersonal process therapy, and medication management.

Jefferson, and Saint Vincent hospitals, disorder interferes with daily living.

Other specialty services

The Alexis Joy D'Achille Center for Perinatal Mental Health is designed to help women who experience perinatal mood and anxiety symptoms, including postpartum depression. It's the first of its kind in the western Pennsylvania and one of only a few in the country.

AHN Center for Traumatic Stress in Children and Adolescents, the first

center of its kind in western Pennsylvania, cares for children who experienced traumatic life events or live with posttraumatic stress disorder.

Neuropsychological testing pinpoints strengths and challenges with cognitive, emotional, and behavioral functioning, establishes a baseline, or tracks changes over time.

Deep transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS) is an option for individuals with depression, when traditional therapies and medicines haven't worked.

Surgery

AHN Surgery Institute is a nationally recognized organ transplantation program. We accept the most complex transplant cases and focus on improving post-transplant outcomes.

Surgeons in our mechanical circulatory assist program helped pioneer implantable cardioverter defibrillators, cardiac resynchronization therapy devices, and left ventricular assist devices. These can be used as a bridge to transplant or as a standalone therapy.

SURGERY FOR BETTER DAYS, LONGER LIVES

AHN is a pioneer in the use of stereotactic body radiation therapy (SBRT) to shrink liver tumors prior to surgical removal or transplant. Shrinking the tumor gives transplant-eligible individuals more time to wait for a donor liver.

As part of the longest chain of kidney transplants ever constructed, our living kidney donor program handled 34 kidneys donated and 34 received.

AHN's commitment to organ, tissue, and cornea donations resulted in 94 lives saved by donated organs, 9,500 lives healed from tissue donations, and 121 individuals granted the gift of sight in 2018.
